The Hunter Indigenous Vocal Scholarship Checklist

The Hunter Indigenous Vocal Scholarship Steps to Application Checklist

- 1. Check criteria (available at www.mtansw.org.au)
- 2. Complete Indigenous Scholarship Application Form with confirmation of Aboriginality.
- 3. Record songs on video.
- 4. Upload video to YouTube unlisted channel & note URL on Indigenous Scholarship Application Form OR attach MP4 file with Indigenous Scholarship Application Form.
- 5. Email completed Indigenous Scholarship Application Form to newcastle@mtansw.org.au by FRIDAY, JULY 7th, 2023 at 5pm.
- 6. Be available for rehearsal on a date **TBC**.
- 7. Be available for scholarship selection day **SATURDAY**, **JULY 29**th, **2023**.
- 8. Be available for scholarship winner return performance at the 2024 Scholarship event, or other event as determined by MTA NSW Newcastle Branch.

Video guidelines:

- 1. The applicant must be visible at all times during their video performance.
- 2. The applicant should state at the commencement of their video the following statement:
- "My name is...... I will be singing followed by"
- 3. The performance should include the two songs as noted in their application form.
- 4. The performance should not exceed 15 minutes and remain uncut.
- 5. The performance may be sung to a backing track, or with a live accompaniment.
- 6. For the scholarship selection process (and the rehearsal in the weeks prior), a pianist will be provided to accompany your performance.
